 - Some skates are missing from the inventory and are clearly marked. Midway should review the list and ensure all missing skates are returned.
 - No fees were collected for summer use of GMSA skates. This should be reviewed as these fees are used for future skate purchases and skate repairs.
 - Adult skates are in good repair and awaiting the 17-18 Sunday and weeknights learn to speed skate days
- Penguin skates about 60 pairs older but in great shape. Sheree has been in contact with an East Coast club that might want to purchase them. Will discuss more next month.
